BINDING CONTRACT

This offer becomes a binding agreement when the provisions herein described are accepted by and executed by the Funeral Home. To provide funding for comparable funeral merchandise and services to those described in the Statement of Funeral Goods and Services Selected, the Insured has purchased a certificate of life insurance or annuity contract from GREAT WESTERN INSURANCE COMPANY, and offers to make Funeral Home the beneficiary thereof. In consideration for designating Funeral Home the beneficiary of the said certificate/contract, Funeral Home agrees to accept the proceeds of said certificate/contract as full payment for comparable merchandise and services at any future date, regardless of any price increases.

EXCESS CERTIFICATE PROCEEDS

Upon death of the Insured, any accumulations of the certificate/contract in excess of the then current charges for comparable merchandise and services selected by my family will be the property of my estate.

EXPENDITURES EXCEEDING CERTIFICATE PROCEEDS

In the event my family selects either higher quality merchandise or services with a cost greater than those described in the Statement of Funeral Good and Services Selected, the additional cost will be paid by my family.

COMMITMENT OF THE INSURED

Insured agrees to keep the certificate/contract in full force, allowing all interest and dividends to accumulate. Insured will not borrow against the proceeds of the certificate. The Insured understands that all increases in death benefits from dividends are assigned to the Funeral Home. Should the certificate/contract become unenforceable for any reason or the death benefits are paid under the suicide clause, this agreement will become null and void.

LIMITATION ON PERFORMANCE AND PRICE GUARANTEE

If the Insured dies by other than accidental means during the first two certificate years, either the family or the estate must pay the difference between the total of this contract and the premiums paid. That amount and the certificate/contract proceeds will be applied to the at-need statement of funeral goods and services selected. Any excess funds will be returned to the family.

IRREVOCABLE ASSIGNMENT OF BENEFITS

The irrevocable assignment transfers the future proceeds of the certificate/contract to the designated funeral establishment, as their interest may appear, and is consideration for this Statement of Funeral Goods and Services Selected. If the insured applies for, or is the recipient of, any public assistance programs in the future, the irrevocable assignment of the certificate/contract may exempt the proceeds from being included in any evaluation of assets and qualification for assistance. The assignment cannot be revoked and the certificate/contract owner retains all other incidents of ownership. Refer to the certificate/contract for other limitations and restrictions.

CHANGE OF INSURED'S ADDRESS

In the event the Insured's permanent residence is moved to a location outside the area normally serviced by Funeral Home, and Insured elects not to return to the said service area for either funeral services or burial, the proceeds of the certificate/contract will be paid to the designated beneficiary, contingent beneficiary or to the Insured's estate. If an Irrevocable Assignment of Benefits has been executed, the Funeral Home agrees to release the proceeds of said certificate/contract to the provider of the funeral services and merchandise.

CANCELLATION

The Statement of Funeral Goods and Services Selected may be canceled at any time. Canceling this Agreement does not cancel your GREAT WESTERN INSURANCE COMPANY certificate/contract. The Purchaser may cancel his or her insurance under the terms and conditions outlined in the insurance documents. The Purchaser will receive the cash value if the certificate/contract is canceled 31 days or more after the issue date. The cash value may be considerably less than the premiums actually paid in.
